

General Race Information:

What: Statesboro’s first multi-sport adventure race! Come out and join us as participants compete in the inaugural Iron Eagle Challenge! The event will consist of off-road/urban cycling, foot travel, canoeing, and many mystery challenges. This is the perfect race for those who have always wanted to try adventure racing and for those who would just like to have a fun time while getting some exercise!

When: Friday, November 11th, 2005, starting at 3:00p.m. sharp! The race is expected to take between 1 and 2 hours to complete. There will be a mandatory pre-race meeting at 2:30p.m.

Where: The race will start and finish at the RAC (Recreation Activity Center) pavilion and will take place entirely within the Georgia Southern University campus. The exact course will be kept secret until the day of the race.

Who: Two person teams will tackle the challenges together in this partner race. This race is designed to challenge adventurers of all abilities, and is open to members of the Georgia Southern campus and surrounding community.

Not a problem! Mention this on your entry form and we will match you up with someone else who is currently racing solo.

Entry Fees: The entry fee for all current Georgia Southern students is \$10.00/person (a valid student I.D. is required). For other members of the Georgia Southern campus and surrounding community the cost is \$20.00/person.

Race Rules and Regulations

- All participants must be at least 16 years of age on the day of the race.
- Race numbers must be visibly worn by each participant for the entire race.
- Prior to the start of the race each team will be given a punch card which must be kept for the duration of the race.
- In order to keep the “adventure” in the race, the course will remain secret until the pre-race meeting.
- All competitors are required to follow the prescribed course and stay within the marked boundaries at all times.
- During the cycling portion of the race, **ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST WEAR A CYCLING HELMET, WITH CHIN STRAP FASTENED, AT ALL TIMES!!** A violation of this rule will result in an immediate disqualification for the team.
- This is a team race. Team members must stay within 50ft of their race partner at all times.
- All traffic regulations must be obeyed.
- Unsportsman-like conduct towards other competitors, volunteers, spectators, or race officials will not be tolerated.
- No equipment will be left on the course. Littering is grounds for immediate disqualification.
- The race will start promptly at 3:00p.m. on Friday, November the 11th, 2005. A mandatory pre-race meeting will take place at 2:30p.m. at the pavilion on race day. Please be on time. Critical race instructions will be given at this time. Late arrivals will not be allowed to race.
- Other rules will be discussed at the pre race meeting.
